- Trustees (and/or their families) do not personally or financially benefit from the Library or from access to Library information.
- A Trustee will disqualify him/herself in the case of a conflict of interest.
- Trustees shall not interfere with the Director's management responsibilities or the Library staff's supervision.
- Trustees support the efforts of librarians in resisting censorship of library materials by groups or individuals.
