NEW BUSINESS:

a. JB Contracting offered two solutions to fix the water leak problem in the basement, but neither option is a guaranteed remedy. JB Contracting is also trying to pass off the cost to resolve the issue, saying that the Village of Shorewood originally approved the work they did. The board wants to know for certain what is happening in the conduit before making any decisions. Director Mills spoke to the lawyer, and it was suggested to have a third-party blow out the air in the conduit and scope it to determine if there are any holes or broken pieces causing the leaks. This would then determine who would be responsible for the cost. If during the scope it is determined that the conduit is broken, an

immediate email will be sent to JB Contracting requiring a written response in three days. Secretary Voitik motioned, and Vice President Schultz seconded the motion to hire Indicom to blow air through the conduit and scope it to determine what is going on inside. The motion passed with all building committee members voting 'yes'.

Vice President Schultz motioned to adjourn at 6:42 pm; Secretary Voitik seconded. The meeting was adjourned.

Please accept the following Electrical Proposal regarding the Shorewood-Troy Library – 2" Conduit at South Parking Lot on Deerwood Drive in Shorewood, IL based on Zoom call Friday 03/21/2025 w/Bret Mitchell and Jennie Mills.

All work associated with the above-mentioned project is to be completed in a substantial workman-like manner. Any/all schedules provided will be contingent upon clean work areas provided by owner/GC in a timely manner and weather being moderate enough to work safely and productively.

Electrical Base Bid (Lump Sum): \$5,390.00

Work Included in Proposal:

- 1. Coordinate with Owner for access to all electrical closets as needed to perform work.
- 2. Rope out Parking Spaces with Cones and Caution Tape at South Lot for pulling equipment/work area.
- 3. Mobilize equipment to pull/clean out 2" conduit from South Lot to Building.
- 4. Free up/Roll out cabling in basement.
- 5. Use Line Truck at South Lot to tie onto and remove existing cabling from 2" conduit and future EV j-box.
- 6. Roll up cabling and meg for viability. *Note it is assumed that this cable will be damaged during demo.
- 7. Use Air Compressor to blow standing water out of 2" underground conduit raceway.
- 8. Use Camera the length of conduit to inspect for breakage/conflict.
- 9. Report results to Library/Architect and Demobilize.
- 10. Equipment Rental included in proposal.

Clarifications:

- 11. No Illinois sales tax included in quote.
- 12. No Local Permit/Inspection Fees/Consumption Costs/Bonding Costs.
- 13. No Weekend Time/Holiday Time/Shift time/Overtime.
- 14. No Temporary Power/Lighting included in pricing.
- 15. No Saw-cutting, Spoil Removal or Landscaping Repairs included in pricing.
- 16. Any/All repairs to underground conduit/cabling required after work above is performed, will be quoted separately. We would not proceed without formal approval from owner.
